Church Security 101:

In today's society, there is a very real threat of violence. Unfortunately, churches are not excluded from this threat. During this seminar, we will take a look at the threats facing churches today and the responsibility of those in authority to protect their congregations. Furthermore, we will equip you with the "how-to's" of creating awareness and developing a plan to create a safe environment for your church families.

Bio:

Mike Mendoza is the Director of Homeland Security and Installation Antiterrorism Advisor at Dover Air Force Base, Delaware. He has 30 years experience as a Security Specialist with the United States Air Force and Department of Defense. Mr. Mendoza has been assigned to Dover Air Force Base for 14 years and has supervised Homeland Security/Antiterrorism operations for the past 10 years. He's a master technician in the areas of antiterrorism, force protection, physical security, resource protection and law enforcement operations. In addition, Mr. Mendoza's is a subject matter expert in conducting Vulnerability Assessments, Security Risk Management, Threat Assessments and protection of Critical Infrastructure. **Mike also spearheaded and established the "first-ever" security team program at Calvary Assembly of God in February 2008 and assumed duties as Gatekeeper Ministry Director.** In this capacity he recruits, trains and manages a 60+ person volunteer force, which performs on-site security during Church services and special events. Dover Gatekeepers stand guard to protect a 1,700 person congregation and are trained to react during emergency situations, reducing security risks to ensure a safe and secure sanctuary for people to experience God without fear.

FROM ROUTE 1 SOUTH: after the Dover toll plaza, take exit 97. At the end of a very long ramp, take a right at the light. Take a right at the next light (South State Street/113A South). Take a left onto Rt. 10 (Lebanon Road). Calvary Assembly of God will be immediately on your left next to Wilmington Trust Bank. The meeting will be held in the FAMILY LIFE CENTER Multi-Purpose Room. Directional signs will be posted.
