Directions to Supplee Presbyterian Church:

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:

Take exit 339 (Fort Washington). After tollbooth, stay in the right lane onto Route 309 North. Proceed a short distance (about 1/4 mile) to the Highland Avenue exit (first exit). Turn right at the bottom of the ramp to the first traffic light. Turn left onto Fort Washington Avenue and proceed about 2 ½ miles to a dead end at Welsh Road. Turn left onto Welsh Road (Route 63). The church entrance is on your left about 0.4 miles. I will have signs as to where to enter for our meeting – will depend on number attending and weather.
