Program: "Coaching Upward"

A common challenge among Delaware Valley Chapter members is "my job is made more difficult by supervisors and/or pastors who do not understand the role of the Church Business Administrator". All too often we feel alone in our quest to adhere to federal, state, and local laws; to treat all personnel fairly; and to do what is right and best for our churches, members and staff. Does this resonate with you? Do you face this challenge in your church?

Val Hastings recently did a workshop at the Nashville NACBA Conference. He spoke to these concerns, and addressed the question, "Can I coach my senior pastor, team leader, or ministry supervisor?" We as Delaware Valley Chapter members are extremely fortunate that Val makes his home in Pottstown, PA. This program will provide each participant with coaching skills, insights, and techniques for coaching upward.

Directions to Limerick Golf Club, 769 North Lewis Road, Limerick, PA 19468

From South and East – take the Schuylkill Expressway (I76) west and then follow the signs for Route 422 West – Pottstown. Take Route 422 West and Exit at the Limerick, Linfield exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp turn right on to Lewis Road. Travel approximately 1 mile and you will see the sign for the golf club on your left. Turn left into the driveway and proceed to the parking lot. Look for the signs for the meeting; we will be on the lower level just off of the outdoor patio area.

From West – take route 422 east to the Limerick, Linfield exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp turn left on to Lewis Road and follow the directions above.
